General Education

This guide lists the general education requirements at the University of St. Francis with Harper courses satisfying USF general education. Students who have completed the IAI (Illinois Articulation Initiative) or A.A. or A.S. requirements have satisfied the general education requirements for the University of St. Francis except for philosophy and theology requirements. *Nursing, Education and Applied Organizational Management programs have specific general education requirements, and therefore, it is necessary to refer to the transfer guides for these majors.* Note: A maximum of 70 s.h. transfers to USF. It is not necessary to complete all Harper courses equivalent to USF courses prior to transferring to the University of St. Francis. Students completing the Associate degree should consult the catalog and with an academic advisor at Harper College.
