**Step 2: Complete your Bachelor's (B. S.) degree in Health Care Leadership**

The B. S. in Health Care Leadership, an accelerated and online bachelor's degree program at the University of St. Francis for the adult student, is designed as a "2+2" for students from College of DuPage who have completed the associate degree and have health care certification, registration or licensure or are currently in supporting health care roles or wish to seek a supportive position in health care. The Health Care Leadership program applies work experience, technical training and coursework to theory in the classroom. Coursework is accepted from any associate degree, which allows students to complete a bachelor's degree in a timely fashion. (Note: A maximum of 80 s.h. from College of DuPage or any community college and/or hospital based program will transfer towards the bachelor's degree in Health Care Leadership. College of DuPage students completing the associate degree should consult the COD catalog and meet with an academic advisor at COD.

### Admission Requirements

The following are required for admission to the Health Care Leadership program:

- A minimum of 64 semester hours of transfer credit or an associate's degree with a minimum of 64 semester hours of transfer credit.
- A minimum 2.0 cumulative G.P.A.
- A minimum age of 23 or two years of significant work experience.
- Completion of the admission application process.

### B.S. in Health Care Leadership Degree Requirements

A total of 128 semester hours is required to earn a bachelor's degree with a minimum of 32 semester hours completed through USF. The number of semester hours needed to complete the program depends on the number of transferable credits towards the bachelor's degree and credit earned through the Prior Learning Assessment Program for college-level learning experience outside the traditional classroom (if applicable).
