The Health Care Leadership program, an accelerated program at the University of St. Francis for the adult student, is designed as a “2+2” for students from College of DuPage who have completed the Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in Human Services and wish to complete a bachelor’s degree. (Note: A maximum of 80 s.h. from the College of DuPage or any community college will transfer towards the bachelor’s degree in Health Care Leadership.
