NURSING

Students at College of DuPage who are preparing to transfer to the University of St. Francis as a nursing major may complete lower-division required courses at the College of DuPage prior to transferring to USF. To complete the BSN, students must complete two years (minimum of 64s.h.) of lower division liberal arts and science courses as prerequisites to the upper-division professional nursing courses. The following lists the lower division courses for the USF Nursing program and the equivalent courses at the College of DuPage. College of DuPage students completing the associate degree at the College of DuPage should consult the College of DuPage catalog and meet with an academic advisor at the College of DuPage.
