General Education

This guide lists the general education requirements at the University of St. Francis with JJC courses satisfying USF general education. Students who have completed the IA (Illinois Articulation Initiative) or A.A. or A.S. requirements have satisfied the general education requirements for the University of St. Francis except for philosophy and theology requirements. *Nursing, Education, Business and Adult Degree Completion programs have specific general education requirements, and therefore, it is necessary to refer to the transfer guides for these majors.* Note: A maximum of 70 s.h. transfers to USF. It is not necessary to complete all JJC courses equivalent to USF courses prior to transferring to the University of St. Francis. Students completing the Associate degree should consult the catalog and with an academic advisor at JJC.

Social Awareness, two courses from two disciplines	Select two from two disciplines: ANTH 101, 275; ECON 103, 104; GEOG 102, 104, 106; PSCI 101, 102, 103; PSYC 101, 208, 210; SOC 101, 270, 280 or 290
Numerical Understanding, one approved course at a level above intermediate algebra	Select one from: MATH 124, 127, 128, 150, 153, 170, 171; BUS 205
Natural Science, one approved course:	Select one from: ASTR 101; BIO 104, 105, 107, 125, 144, 146, 151, 152; CHEM 100, 101, 102, 104, 108; GEOG 111, 112; GEOL 101; PHYS 100, 101, 102; PHSCI 120
One Math, Science or Computer Science approved elective:	Select one from: the suggested math or science courses as listed above or CIS 122, 124, 126, 130, 134, 136; BIO 250, 251 (see note below)

Note: Business majors entering USF Fall 20010 will be required to take BSAD 250 Business Driven Technology at USF rather than CIS 122, 124 or 126. BSAD 250 is not an approved computer science general education course.
