## Bachelor of Science in MANAGEMENT

The Bachelor of Science in Management degree is designed as a “2+2” program for adult students wishing to complete an accelerated business degree. This degree offers the adult student an accelerated curriculum online which applies work experience, technical training and coursework to the theory in the classroom. The “2+2” program accepts coursework taken as part of any associate degree which allows students to complete a bachelor’s degree in a timely fashion. The Management degree also accepts credit as awarded through the Prior Learning Assessment Program for learning experiences gained from certificate programs, training programs and life experiences. **This guide lists the general education and program requirements for the B.S. in Management with the course equivalencies available at Joliet Junior College.** A maximum of 80 s.h. from JJC or any community college will transfer towards the B.S. in Management degree. JJC students completing the associate degree should consult the JJC catalog and meet with an academic advisor at JJC.
