Health Care Leadership

For students who have completed the associate's degree or who have health care certification, registration or licensure or are currently in supporting health care roles or who wish to seek a supportive position in health care, the University of St. Francis provides a Bachelor of Science degree in Health Care Leadership. This degree offers the adult student an **accelerated** curriculum which applies work experience, technical training and coursework to theory in the classroom. Coursework is accepted from any associate degree, which allows students to complete a bachelor's degree in a timely fashion. A maximum of 80 s.h. from JJC or any community college will transfer towards the Bachelor of Science Health Care Leadership degree. JJC students completing the associate degree should consult the JJC catalog and meet with an academic advisor at JJC.

Admission Requirements

The following are required for admission to the Health Care Leadership program:

- 64 semester hours of transfer credit or an associate's degree with a minimum of 64 semester hours of transfer credit.
- A minimum 2.0 cumulative G.P.A.
- Completion of the admission application process.

A maximum of 80 semester hours may transfer from a community college and/or hospital based program.

B.S. Degree Requirements, Health Care Leadership

A total of 128 semester hours is required to earn a bachelor's degree with a minimum of 32 semester hours taken through USF. The number of semester hours needed to complete the program depends on the number of transferable credits towards the degree and credit earned through the Prior Learning Assessment Program for college-level learning experienced outside the traditional classroom (if applicable).
