Bachelor of Science Health Care Leadership

The B. S. in Health Care Leadership, an accelerated and online bachelor's degree program at the University of St. Francis for the adult student, is designed as a "2+2" for students from Valencia Community College who have completed the associate degree and have health care certification, registration or licensure or are currently in supporting health care roles or wish to seek a supportive position in health care. The Health Care Leadership program applies work experience, technical training and coursework to theory in the classroom. Coursework is accepted from any associate degree, which allows students to complete a bachelor's degree in a timely fashion. A maximum of 80 s.h. from Valencia Community College or any community college and/or hospital based program will transfer towards the bachelor's degree in Health Care Leadership. Valencia students completing the associate degree should consult the Valencia catalog and meet with an academic advisor at Valencia Community College.
