Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership

The University of St. Francis provides a B.S. degree in Organizational Leadership for students who have completed the associate's degree and wish to strengthen their own performance or want to assume a leadership position within an organization. The Organizational Leadership program applies work experience, technical training and coursework to theory in the classroom. Coursework is accepted from any associate degree, which allows students to complete a bachelor's degree in a timely fashion. A maximum of 80 s.h. from Valencia Community College or any community college will transfer towards the bachelor's degree in Organizational Leadership. Valencia Community College students completing the associate degree should consult the Valencia catalog and meet with an academic advisor at Valencia Community College.
