Accessing Google Scholar

Access is available at the website www.scholar.google.com and through the library database page. Full text articles and PDF's are occasionally available on Google Scholar. Be sure to set your Google Scholar Preferences to enable linking to the USF Library holdings.

Scope and Coverage

Google Scholar indexes all available subject areas and does not have a higher concentration of any particular area of study. Google Scholar functions by taking information collected by various databases and making citation information and occasionally full text available on the open web.

Find articles with **all of the words**, with the **exact phrase**, with **at least one** of the words, **without** the words, or where my words occur. **anywhere in the article**

Author Return articles written by e.g., "PJ Hayes" or McCarthy

Publication Return articles published in e.g., J Biol Chem or Nature

Date Return articles published between - e.g., 1996

Subject Areas

- Return articles in all subject areas.
- Return only articles in the following subject areas:
 - Biology, Life Sciences, and Environmental Science
 - Business, Administration, Finance, and Economics
 - Chemistry and Materials Science
 - Engineering, Computer Science, and Mathematics
 - Medicine, Pharmacology, and Veterinary Science
 - Physics, Astronomy, and Planetary Science
 - Social Sciences, Arts, and Humanities
