Google on Thursday said that Google Sky, previously a star-viewing option in the Google Earth desktop application, can now be viewed on its own in a Web browser.

\*Sky in Google Earth, which launched last August, was originally available to our 350 million Google manager Lior Ron in a blog post. \*This release brings the universe to every browser and makes Sky accessible to just about anyone with an internet connection -- from school children to professional astronomers -- in 26 different languages.\*
