The American Association for Women in Community Colleges was organized in 1973 and became a Council of the American Association of Community and Junior Colleges (AACJC), now the American Association for Community Colleges (AACC). In response to an affirmative vote of the membership, the organization's name was officially changed on April 26, 1993 to the American Association for Women in Community Colleges (AAWCC).

The AAWCC provides professional development opportunities, networking connections and publications about activities involving women in the community college.

The organization promotes leadership for women at all levels of our colleges.

Recommends and reports on issues pertaining to higher education in general and community colleges specifically.

## *JJC AAWCC Chapter*

The American Association for Women in the Community College National Board voted to accept the JJC Chapter application in 2000, as an official affiliate of the AAWCC.
