### Declaration of Financial Support:

If it is determined that you are admissible to the University of St. Francis, USF can provide you with an I-20 (F-1) only after you submit satisfactory evidence that you have adequate funds for your proposed program of study and submit any required deposits. Acceptable financial documents must not have been issued more than five (5) months before the term you intend to enroll at USF and must accompany this form. Be sure to keep copies of these documents as you will need to present them to the U.S. Consular Officer at your visa interview and to the U.S. Immigration Officers at the Port of Entry. Please note: U.S. visa regulations restrict student employment, and therefore, it is important not to rely on employment for income to offset your education expenses.

### Estimated Costs:

As an ELAP student at USF, you will need the below USD estimated amount for the academic year in accordance with your program of choice. These figures cover the cost of tuition, fees, and a modest estimate for room, board, books, supplies, transportation, health insurance, and incidental expenses.

Estimates above are for one year of ELAP. Costs tend to increase slightly from year to year. To help you prepare financially, be aware that the ELAP program generally takes one (1) year to complete. You and your sponsor (if applicable) must be prepared to meet the ongoing costs of your educational and living expenses, not only for the first academic year, but also for the duration of your studies at USF.
