We anticipate that you will be eligible to receive a Monetary Award from the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) for the 2019-2020 academic year. Before the funds can be disbursed, Financial Aid Services must verify your Illinois residency. ISAC rules state that a self supporting student is considered a resident of Illinois if he/she meets the following criteria:

"An independent student is a resident of Illinois if the applicant has a true, fixed and permanent home within the State of Illinois (at the time of application) and has so resided for a period of 12 continuous, full months immediately prior to the start of the academic year for which assistance is requested."

This means that you must have resided in Illinois prior to **August 19, 2018**. Please complete the attached form and return it to our office with **one** of the documents listed. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please call our office.

Illinois Residency Verification 2019-2020

I understand that I must be a resident of Illinois to receive financial assistance under the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) Monetary Award Program. Further, I understand that Illinois residency is defined by the ISAC to be the following:

"An Independent Student is a Resident of Illinois if the applicant has a true, fixed and permanent home within the State of Illinois (at the time of application) and has so resided for a period of 12 continuous, full months immediately prior to the start of the academic year for which assistance is requested."
