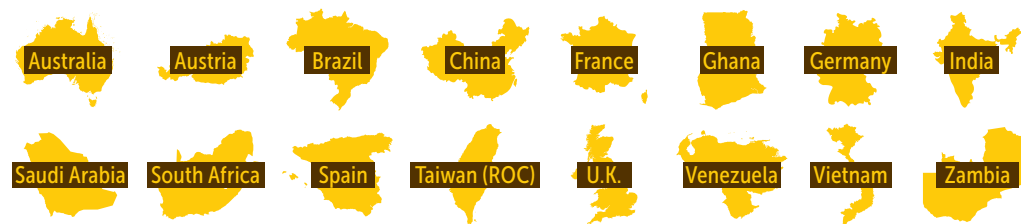

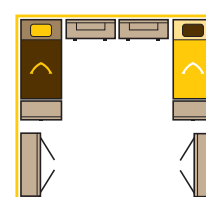
### HOUSING FEES (DOUBLE OCCUPANCY)
