The **University of St. Francis** is a private, Catholic university founded in 1920 by the Sisters of St. Francis of Mary Immaculate (the "Joliet Franciscans").

LOCATION

USF's quaint, residential campus is located in **Joliet, Illinois**, just 35 miles southwest of Chicago. The main campus is situated in the historic Cathedral Area, and is connected to USF's St. Bonaventure and St. Clare campuses by a convenient shuttle service. Joliet is easily accessible by major interstates (I-55 & I-80), by rail, and by air through Chicago's Midway and O'Hare Airports. USF also operates a small campus in **Albuquerque, New Mexico**, which is home to the USF Physician Assistant program.

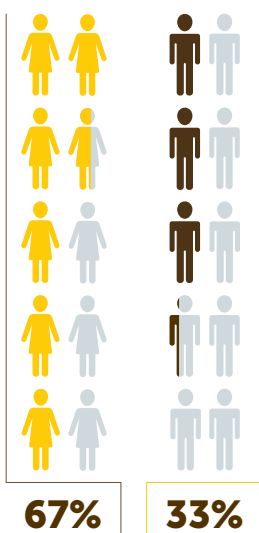

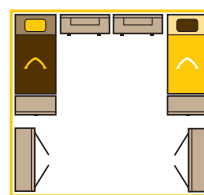
HOUSING FEES (DOUBLE OCCUPANCY)
