Alumni Association Board of Directors Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Alumni Association Board of Directors' purpose?

- Support the Alumni & Family Relations Office
- Serve as ambassadors for the University to assist with awareness, positive public image, recruitment of students, and fundraising efforts to support student scholarships
- Serve as a source of support and mentorship for current students and alumni
- Build and promote positive relationships with alumni that foster affinity, loyalty and support for the University
- Reflect USF Franciscan values
- Be an extension of USF within your local community

What is the time commitment of members?

- Attendance at 4 meetings annually
- Membership on at least one committee
- Participation at alumni and university sponsored events and programs including Homecoming & Reunion

What are the responsibilities of the Alumni Association?

- Attendance at a minimum of 51% of meetings (at least 3 of 4 meetings annually)
- Membership on at least one committee
- Financial contribution to the Francis Fund annually to support student scholarships
- Support the Alumni & Family Relations Office
- Serve as ambassadors for the University to assist with awareness, positive public image, recruitment, and fundraising
- Participation at alumni and university sponsored events and programs
