Finish at the University of St. Francis!***

Nursing

Students at Truman College who are preparing to transfer to the University of St. Francis as a nursing major may complete lower-division required courses at Truman College prior to transferring to USF. To complete the BSN, students must complete two years (minimum of 64 s.h.) of lower division liberal arts and science courses as prerequisites to the upper-division professional nursing courses. The following lists the lower division courses for the USF Nursing program and the equivalent courses at Truman. Students completing the associate degree at Truman should consult the Truman catalog and meet with an academic advisor at Truman.

The TEAS exam is required to enroll in the following nursing courses NURS 250, 265 and 270 which are taken within 1-2 semesters prior to the first clinical semester. In addition, a minimum 2.75 cumulative g.p.a in general education, nursing and perquisite courses is also required.

NURS 250 Concepts of Professional Nursing (3 s.h.)	Must be taken at USF
NURS 265 Health Promotion & Family Assessment (3 s.h.)	Must be taken at USF
NURS 270 Health and Aging (3 s.h.)	Must be taken at USF

3 of the 5 following general education courses must be completed prior to enrolling in upper-level (300-400) nursing courses.

Philosophy, one course (3 s.h.)	Select one from: PHIL 105, 106, 107 (3 s.h.)
Introduction to Theology (3 s.h.)	Must be taken at USF
Oral Communication, Speech (3 s.h.)	SPEECH 101 (3 s.h.)
Literature, one course (3 s.h.)	Select one from: LIT 110 (recommended) , or 111, 112, 113, 116, 117, 118, 119 or 150 (3 s.h.)
History, one course (3 s.h.)	Select one from: HISTORY 111, 112, 141, 142, 215, 247 or 248 (3 s.h.)

Effective for Fall 2006, admission into the clinical sequence requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 in all general education and pre-requisite courses. Included in this GPA are any nursing course grades from other institutions. Transfer students meeting the above requirements are not guaranteed entry into the clinical course sequence. Requirements are subject to change. Please consult with a USF admissions counselor each semester prior to enrollment at USF.
