

Study Abroad Process and Policy

University of St. Francis encourages all students to participate in a study abroad experience. Students can participate in short-term or semester-long faculty-led programs when available. They may also enroll in one of our exchange partner programs, consortium programs, affiliated programs, or third party provider programs. Students will work with the International Programs Office, academic department, and Financial Aid to determine which program is best for their major, interests, and financial situation. Students will select courses that will be pre-approved by the International Programs Office, Registrar's Office, and Academic Department before departing USF to the partner university. The host institution will provide a final grade report at the end of the program, after which the student's grades will be entered at USF.
